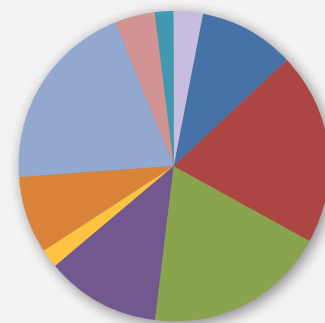

## Matching Donor Advised Fund

Matched giving programs enable a company to support a large number of causes while at the same time strengthening its corporate image among employees and the broader public. By establishing a MDAF at CAFAmerica, corporations can tax effectively support the international philanthropic goals of their employees, matching employee contributions and/or volunteer time. Designed to support corporate international matched giving, the CAFAmerica Matching Donor Advised Fund (MDAF) provides the flexibility to manage a program of any type or size. CAFAmerica's expertise in working with foreign non-profits ensures that all grants are made safely and effectively to legitimate charitable organizations.

## Administrative Cost Per Calendar Year

- Account management and first 20 grants: \$5,000
- 21-50 grants (50 total): additional \$7,000
- 51-75 grants (75 total): additional \$5,000
- 76-100 grants (100 total): additional \$5,000
- Each additional 25 grants (over 100): additional \$6,000
- \$1,000 one time set-up charge
- \$5,000 minimum balance

## Per Due Diligence Review Charge: \$500

- Due Diligence would be required for any organization not already eligible with CAFAmerica
- This charge is not applicable on grant suggestions for nonprofits that fit the following criteria:
  - Eligible with CAFAmerica
  - Registered with the Charity Commission of England & Wales
  - Registered with the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator
  - Registered with the Charity Commission of Northern Ireland
  - Registered as a Deductible Gift Recipient entity and fund in Australia
